Scholarship Name:	Ivo Garofalo Scholarship
Scholarship Amount:	\$2,000 is available annually, whether as one scholarship or several; the scholarship is not renewable beyond the student's first year of college.

Donor:	Kiwanis Club of Kenosha Breakfast - <i>funded annually</i>
Who nominates Students?	School Personnel (Teachers, Counselors, Principals, etc.) <u>Nominations are screened by each school</u> ; the Club will consider only one nominee per school. Nominees are not guaranteed to receive scholarship awards. Nominations must be received by the Club before April 30.
Who Selects Winners?	The Club will select winner(s) based on answer to this essay topic: "What does 'community' mean to you, and how can you help make your community better?" The essay should be typed, and should be no longer than one page. The scholarship is good for the first academic year only, will be paid directly to the school (not the individual), and will be divided evenly across the terms of the first year at the school attended.
Criteria/Restrictions: (verification will be required for each)	Applicant must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. be a resident of Kenosha County 2. be a student with learning disabilities documented in an IEP (Individual Educational Plan), or with documented physical disabilities 3. be a high school senior, graduating from a Kenosha County high school with a minimum 3.0 cumulative gpa 4. be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited institution of higher education 5. maintain at least a 2.25 gpa after the first term in order for the scholarship to be renewed for the next term, until the first calendar year is ended and the scholarship exhausted <p><i>Members or relatives of members of the Kiwanis Club of Kenosha Breakfast are not eligible for the scholarship.</i></p>
Biographical Information:	This scholarship honors Ivo Garofalo, a founding member of the Kiwanis Club of Kenosha Breakfast, in recognition of his tireless work to make Kenosha a better place to live, and in response to the generosity of an anonymous donor who funded the Club's smoke detector distribution program for Kenosha County.
